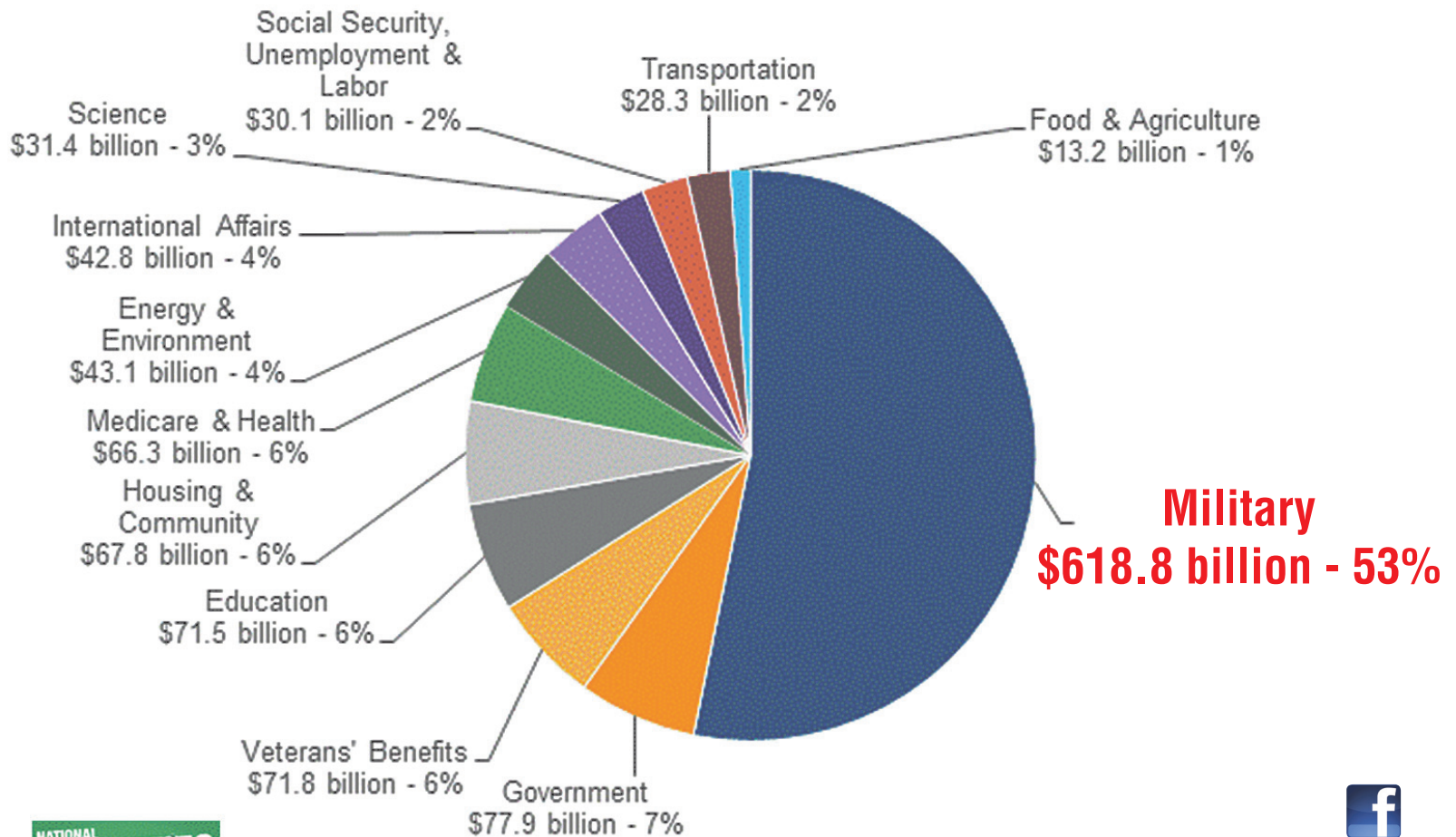

Decrease Trump's bloated military budget!

Our taxes should fund peace and social justice, not war and nuclear build-up. The pie chart reflects the current immense government spending on the military. Worse yet, Donald Trump's budget proposals would *raise* the military's budget by more than \$50 billion dollars next year, with an additional \$1.4 billion increase going to nuclear weapons programs at the Department of Energy.

To fund these large increases, Trump proposes severe cuts to education, health, the arts, scientific research, environmental protection, foreign aid programs, and domestic social services. A recent University of Maryland survey shows that the typical U.S. voter would cut Pentagon spending by an average of \$41 billion, not increase it as Trump proposes. (Both Republicans and Democrats were included in the survey.) We must oppose Trump's budget!
