You may, or may not know, GVCP was founded in 1972. We are a chapter of Peace Action New York State. This is our 49th annual Hiroshima and Nagasaki Commemoration. There's NO war that will end all wars. War breeds war. Our country is complicit in perpetuating war. In the words of the late poet Mary Oliver, "What keeps us from falling down, our faces to the ground, ashamed, ashamed?"

Still, there is hope... There are things we can do to counter war, to work to stop nuclear weapons. I encourage ALL of you to contact your representatives, ask them to co-sponsor

H. Res. 77:

- -embracing the goals and provisions of the Treaty in the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons, including pursuing negotiations on new bilateral nuclear arms control and disarmament
- -renouncing the option of First Use
- -ending the President's sole authority to launch a nuclear attack
- -take US nuclear weapons off hair trigger alert, and
- -cancel plan to replace nuclear arsenal of the US with modernized, enhanced weapons

Also, ask your representatives to co-sponsor Congresswoman Eleanor Holmes Norton's **H.R. 2775**:

The Nuclear Weapons Abolition and Economic Economic Conversion Act of 2023, also known as Warheads to Windmills, the bill seeks to convert nuclear industry resources and personnel to purposes relating to addressing the Climate Crisis.

Also, ask your <u>senators</u> to introduce and support similar legislation to H.. Res.77 and H.R. 2775.
